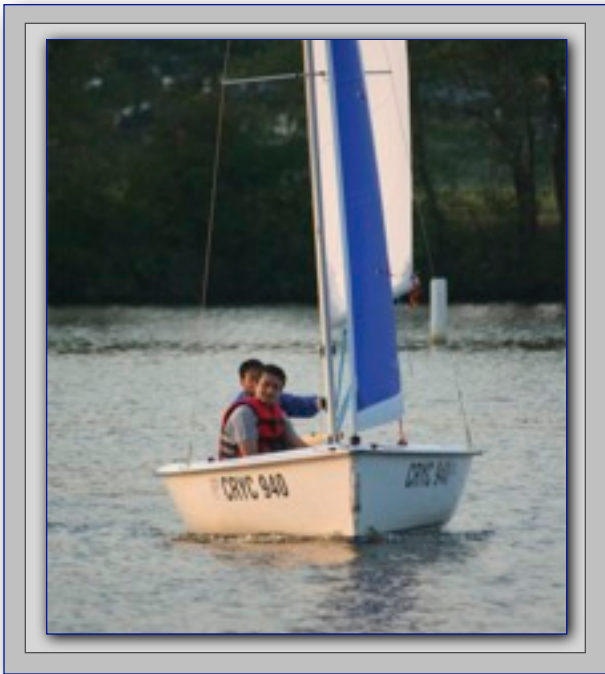

SAIL ON THE COOPER RIVER

Come sail on the Cooper River in the 2009 Cooper River Yacht Club's Community Sailing Program. It's for sailors who do not own their own sailboat.

CRYC has a fleet of sailboats for CRYC Community Sailors.

Come join the CRYC and Community Sailing.



The annual cost for the Community Sailing Program (CSP) is \$225. The CSP fee is in addition to the annual \$225 CRYC membership fee.

This is only \$125 more than a CRYC member who owns and stores a boat at the club would pay. For this additional fee, the community sailor has a full season's use of the club's Community Sailing boats.

All current and new CRYC members are urged to join the Community Sailing Program and sail the club's boats. With the new equipment, and the boats in the water when you arrive, this will be a very popular program. As membership in the Community Sailing Program increases, it is anticipated that the sailboats will be available seven days a week.

The existence of Cooper River Yacht Club depends heavily on the volunteer help of its members. All new Community Sailing members will be assigned to the Community Sailing Committee during the first year of membership. As a new member, you will have an opportunity to guide the future of the Community Sailing Program at the Cooper River Yacht Club.

2009 CRYC Community Sailing Program

The Cooper River Yacht Club announces the new 2009 Community Sailing Program. The goal is to make sailing more accessible to new and existing members and to encourage utilization of the club's new sailboats and equipment, as well as a few of the old time favorites.

An online calendar showing all the available boats and times will be published. The goal is to implement online registration for the boat of your choice. Telephone registration will also be available. You will be able to reserve your boat up to one week in advance. Once the sailing season is underway, daily sailboat registration will be available.

The Cooper River Yacht Club will have staff available to check the boats out and in at the scheduled dates and times. The staff will also be on hand with a safety boat to provide that additional level of comfort — knowing help is not far away if needed. Boats that are reserved in advance can be in the water, ready to sail, when you arrive. This will maximize your time in the boat, as well as being a great convenience. Assistance putting the boats away may also be available.

To help keep the boats in good condition, all community sailors must be certified on each type of boat they want to use. That will be as easy as demonstrating knowledge of rigging, launching, sailing from point A to point B (upwind) and returning safely to the dock.

Several dates for certification will be announced during the spring and summer. There will always be opportunities for you to become certified on additional boats during the season.
