The CRYC also offers **Community Sailing**, which enables members to use any of the club's fleet of the **seven different classes of sail boats: Blue Jay, DC, Vanguard, GP14, Club FJ, Laser, and Sunfish.** **Community Sailing** is an excellent way to personally experience each of the different types of sailboats, helping members who may be considering the purchase of their own sailboats to make informed decisions based on hands-on experiences.
